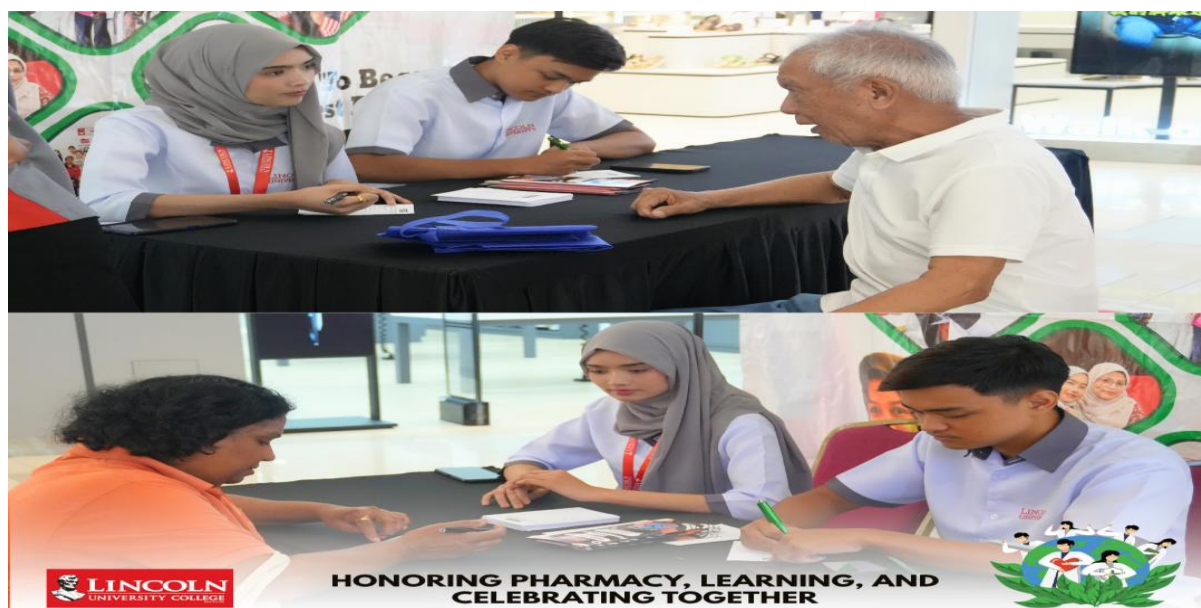

World Pharmacists Day 2025: Think Health, Think Pharmacist

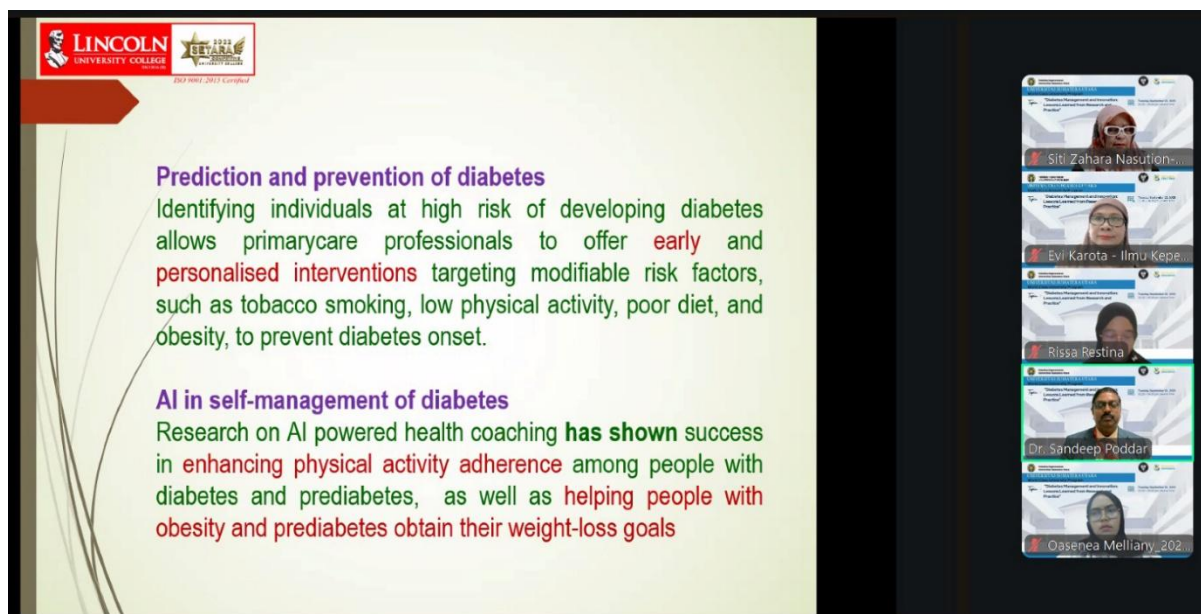

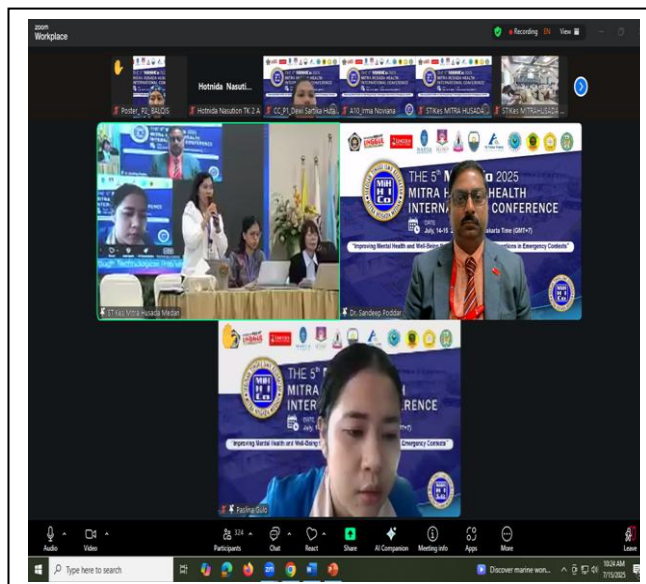

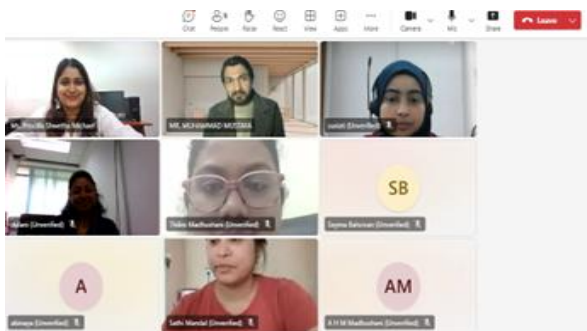
5th International Conference on "Transformational Impact of AI on Business Competitiveness"

Analysis of Outreach Themes & Impact

From the above events, some key themes and observations emerge:

Skills and Capacity Building

Workshops on SPSS, abstract writing, AI & data innovation, phlebotomy training are all oriented toward developing marketable skills (quantitative, tech, health). These are of value not only to enrolled students but also to external learners or those considering entering these fields.

Pre-University / School Leaver Engagement

The Academic Expo at Sarawak targeting SPM leavers is a clear example of outreach intended to assist pre-tertiary students in making choices about further education.

Inclusion & Awareness

Events like the neurodiversity seminar contribute to awareness, inclusion, and addressing diversity issues in higher education. They engage broader stakeholders (educators, policymakers, public) beyond just student audiences.

Institutional & International Collaboration

The MoU with the Commonwealth Youth Network shows LUC's willingness to partner for youth empowerment and broader educational cooperation, which could lead to more outreach programmes.

Practical Hands-On Learning

Workshops with hands-on components (e.g. phlebotomy) offer experiential learning, which is essential for vocational and applied fields. These are beneficial to learners outside fully academic tracks.
