This report highlights Lincoln University College Malaysia's (LUC) proactive role in initiating and participating in cross-sectoral dialogues addressing the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). LUC acts as a convenor and collaborator, bringing together diverse stakeholders such as government ministries, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), private industries, and academic institutions to foster discussions, knowledge sharing, and policy development aligned with national and regional SDG priorities.

1. Institutional Commitment to Cross-Sectoral Dialogue

1.1 Alignment with SDG 17: Partnerships for the Goals

LUC aligns its institutional strategy with SDG 17, focusing on strengthening partnerships among academia, government, and civil society. Through its faculties and dedicated centres, the university supports initiatives that enhance policy coherence and intersectoral collaboration for sustainable development.

1.2 Integration of Dialogue into the Institutional Framework

The university's annual academic calendar includes conferences, symposiums, and workshops addressing multidisciplinary aspects of the SDGs. These events facilitate dialogue between educators, policymakers, community leaders, and researchers.

2. Initiatives Organised by Lincoln University College

2.1 International Conferences on Education, Technology, Management, and Social Sciences (ICETMTSHS)

These flagship conferences serve as platforms for SDG-focused dialogues, engaging government agencies, NGOs, and community-based organizations.

Topics discussed include sustainable healthcare systems, climate action, gender equality, and quality education.

2.2 Sustainability and Health Science Symposiums

These events encourage interdisciplinary engagement between public health officials, educators, and social welfare NGOs to address SDGs 3 (Good Health and Well-being) and 4 (Quality Education).

Outputs from these events are compiled into proceedings and policy recommendations shared with relevant government departments.

Faculty-Led Roundtable Dialogues

Faculties within LUC host roundtable sessions focusing on specific SDG targets. For example, sessions under the Faculty of Social Science and Humanities engage local authorities and NGO representatives on youth empowerment and gender inclusivity.

Governmental and NGO Collaborations

LUC faculty members participate in national SDG consultation forums organized by Malaysian ministries such as the Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE) and Ministry of Environment and Water (KASA).

The university has also contributed to regional dialogues hosted by ASEAN-related academic networks.



Aligning with the "International Day of Action for Women's Health", the conference centered on the theme "Combating Zero Hunger & Women Empowerment".







These activities have been in line with our LUC Faculty of Medicine's motto "Nurturing Competent, Conscience & Compassionate Global Doctors"








