


# Participation in International Collaboration on Gathering and Measuring Data for the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

#### Pathways to Global Sustainability



Lincoln University College (LUC), Malaysia, actively participates in international collaborations focused on data collection, measurement, and research aligned with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The university contributes to both academic and applied projects that enhance global understanding of SDG indicators — particularly in areas of education quality, health promotion, gender equality, and environmental sustainability.

This report outlines LUC's institutional mechanisms, research partnerships, data-driven initiatives, and international engagements that support SDG data gathering, benchmarking, and monitoring at both national and regional levels.

#### National and Regional Data Contributions

Malaysian SDG Data Network Participation

LUC participates in national SDG data workshops and policy dialogues coordinated by the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) and Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE) to align institutional indicators with national reporting mechanisms.

Data Sharing through Government and NGO Partnerships

Data from LUC's community projects — particularly on health education and rural women's empowerment — are shared with NGOs and government bodies contributing to SDG monitoring reports at the regional level.

**Data Analytics and Capacity Building** 

The Faculty of Computer Science and Multimedia conducts workshops on data analytics for sustainability, training students and professionals in data visualization, impact assessment, and SDG metric interpretation.

The university also integrates data-driven learning modules in research methodology courses, building institutional expertise in SDG data gathering.

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This MoU marks a significant step in expanding RIET's global academic collaborations and enhancing opportunities for students and faculty to engage with international institutions of repute.


### Lincoln University College Signs MoU with Shouzheng Innovation Foundation and Wenzhi Traditional Chinese Medicine
