




Her participation underscores Lincoln University College's commitment to cultural dialogue and academic excellence on international platforms.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

Preamble

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made on this **[Date]**, by and between **Lincoln University College**, an institution devoted to lifelong learning and community engagement, and **SPM Tutorial Centre Group**, a leading educational group focused on supporting students preparing for the Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) examinations.

This MOU outlines the collaboration between both parties to organize and host public educational events, including lectures, seminars, and tutorial sessions, at Lincoln University College's campus for the benefit of the general public.

1. Purpose of Collaboration

Lincoln University College and SPM Tutorial Centre Group agree to collaborate on hosting **public educational events** aimed at fostering lifelong learning within the community. These events will include:

- **Public lectures** on various educational and professional topics.
- Seminars and workshops that provide valuable insights and learning opportunities.
- **Tutorial sessions** specifically geared towards aiding students in SPM preparation.

2. Types of Events and Schedule

The events may be organized:

- On an **ad hoc basis** in response to immediate educational needs or opportunities.
- On a programmed basis, following a structured calendar that includes regular public lectures, seminars, and tutorials to maximize community engagement and learning impact.

3. Roles and Responsibilities

- **Lincoln University College** will provide the venue, logistical support, and administrative resources to facilitate the organization of events at its campus.
- **SPM Tutorial Centre Group** will provide expert speakers, facilitators, and educational materials for events, focusing on topics relevant to lifelong learning and SPM preparation.

4. Promotion and Community Engagement

Both parties will jointly promote these events through social media, newsletters, and other

communication channels to maximize public participation and ensure events are well-

attended by members of the community.

5. Monitoring and Feedback

The effectiveness of the events will be evaluated through:

• Feedback forms distributed to attendees to gauge satisfaction and areas for

improvement.

Regular review meetings between representatives of both parties to discuss the

progress and potential enhancements for future events.

6. Duration of the MOU

This MOU is effective from the date of signing and will remain in effect for 2 years, with the

option to renew or modify upon mutual agreement of both parties.

7. Amendments

Any amendments to this MOU must be in writing and signed by authorized representatives of

Lincoln University College and SPM Tutorial Centre Group.

8. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising from this MOU will be resolved amicably through mutual discussion,





These activities have been in line with our LUC Faculty of Medicine's motto "Nurturing Competent, Conscience & Compassionate Global Doctors"








