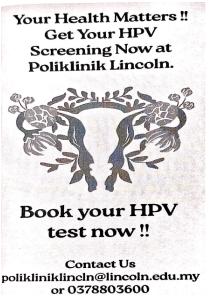
Access to Health-Care Services

a. Poliklinik Lincoln

Poliklinik Lincoln, located within the university premises, serves as the primary health-care facility for students, staff, and the surrounding community. The clinic provides a range of medical and preventive health-care services, including:

Routine medical consultations and health screening.

Sexual and reproductive health-care services, such as counselling on family planning, menstrual health, contraception, and safe sexual practices.

Education and awareness programmes related to sexually transmitted infections (STIs) and preventive care.



Confidential consultations for students seeking reproductive or sexual health advice.

Poliklinik Lincoln plays a vital role in offering accessible and student-friendly health services, ensuring privacy, empathy, and professional support for all individuals seeking SRH-related care.



b. Mazura Healthcare

Mazura Healthcare, another unit affiliated with Lincoln University College, provides extended health-care services to students and the public. The facility complements the work of Poliklinik Lincoln by offering specialized care, preventive health education, and public health outreach.

Key areas of service include:

Reproductive health consultations and maternal health services.

Health promotion activities focused on adolescent and women's health.

Collaboration with academic faculties (especially Nursing and Public Health) to integrate SRH education into student learning and practical training.

Preventive health counselling sessions, which include safe motherhood, fertility awareness, and healthy relationship education.

Through these efforts, Mazura Healthcare ensures that the university community receives holistic, evidence-based, and compassionate reproductive health care.

3. Information and Educational Services

Lincoln University College integrates sexual and reproductive health education within its academic and co-curricular activities. The educational initiatives focus on increasing awareness, promoting responsible behavior, and empowering students with accurate information.

Key initiatives include:

Health awareness campaigns conducted in collaboration with Poliklinik Lincoln and Mazura Healthcare, covering topics such as STI prevention, reproductive anatomy, contraception, and gender-based health issues.



Health talks and seminars delivered by medical and nursing professionals to enhance student understanding of reproductive health rights and responsibilities.

Practical learning sessions for nursing and public health students, who participate in community health programmes addressing reproductive health education and awareness.

Confidential counselling services that ensure students can seek guidance safely and without stigma. These educational activities are designed to cultivate an informed student body that values both personal and community well-being.

4. Impact and Outcomes

Through the combined services of Poliklinik Lincoln and Mazura Healthcare, Lincoln University College has created an inclusive environment where students are:

Encouraged to seek accurate and responsible information about sexual and reproductive health.

Provided access to preventive and curative services to maintain their well-being.

Supported in building confidence and awareness about personal health choices.

This initiative reflects the university's dedication to health promotion, preventive care, and social responsibility within the campus community and beyond.

Lincoln University College demonstrates its commitment to student well-being by providing access to sexual and reproductive health-care services and education through Poliklinik Lincoln and Mazura Healthcare. These facilities not only deliver essential medical care but also serve as platforms for awareness, education, and empowerment.

By integrating health services with educational initiatives, LUC continues to uphold its mission of nurturing responsible, healthy, and knowledgeable individuals who contribute positively to society.

Memorandum of Agreement (MOA)

Between

Lincoln University College Student Affairs Unit

And

Lincoln University College Polyclinic, Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences



1. Purpose

The purpose of this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is to establish a collaborative framework between the Lincoln University College Student Affairs Unit and the Lincoln University College Polyclinic. This partnership aims to improve students' access to sexual and reproductive health-care services, thereby enhancing overall student well-being and aligning with the objectives of **Sustainable Development Goal 3** (SDG 3).

2. Objectives

- To provide accessible, comprehensive sexual and reproductive health services to students.
- To deliver educational programs on sexual and reproductive health issues.
- To foster a safe and supportive environment for discussing sexual and reproductive health concerns.

3. Scope of Collaboration

The Parties agree to collaborate on the following initiatives:

3.1 Free Access Services

- On-Campus Health Clinics: The Polyclinic will provide free sexual and reproductive health services, including STI testing, contraception counselling, and mental health support.
- Workshops and Seminars: The Student Affairs Unit will organize workshops and educational seminars on topics related to sexual and reproductive health, with the Polyclinic providing expert speakers and resources.

3.2 Charged Access Services

- **Specialist Consultations**: The Polyclinic will offer low-cost consultations for more specialized services (e.g., gynaecological exams, advanced contraceptive methods) with a fee structure to be determined.
- **Health Packages**: The Parties will create affordable health packages that include reproductive health services and wellness check-ups.

4. Roles and Responsibilities

Each Party has defined roles and responsibilities to ensure the successful implementation of this agreement:

Lincoln University College Student Affairs Unit:

- **Promote Health Services**: Actively promote the availability of sexual and reproductive health services to students through various channels, including newsletters, social media, and campus events.
- **Organize Events**: Coordinate educational programs, health fairs, and awareness campaigns in collaboration with the Polyclinic.

• **Collect Feedback**: Gather student feedback on health services provided and relay this information to the Polyclinic for continuous improvement.

Lincoln University College Polyclinic:

- **Provide Medical Services**: Deliver sexual and reproductive health services on campus, ensuring accessibility and confidentiality for students.
- **Training and Support**: Train health professionals and staff on delivering youth-friendly sexual and reproductive health services.
- **Conduct Health Assessments**: Monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of the health services offered, including tracking student engagement and health outcomes.

5. Confidentiality

Both Parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of all sensitive information pertaining to students and the services provided, in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

6. Duration and Termination

This MOA shall be effective for a period of **three (3) years** from the date of signing and may be extended by mutual agreement. Either Party may terminate the agreement with at least **ninety (90) days** written notice to the other Party.

7. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising from this MOA shall be resolved amicably through discussions between the Parties. If resolution is not achieved, the Parties may seek mediation.

8. Amendments

This MOA may be amended only by written agreement of both Parties.

This **MOA** outlines the collaborative framework between the **Student Affairs Unit** and the **Polyclinic**, focusing on improving access to sexual and reproductive health-care services for students. By fostering a partnership aimed at enhancing student well-being, both entities can contribute significantly to achieving **SDG 3** objectives within the university community.

- 3. **Participate in Workshops**: Keep an eye on announcements regarding upcoming workshops and events focusing on sexual and reproductive health topics.

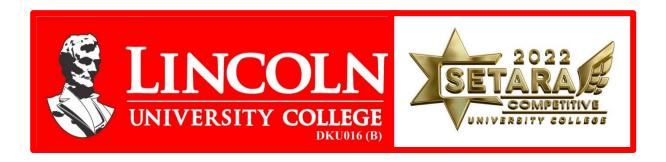
